St. Michael & All Angels Church is an open minded, non-judgmental and inclusive community. Youth activities are designed to bring youth together to grow in faith, friendship and community with one another and to have fun! In order to ensure the safety, comfort and well being of all youth we ask that all participants respect the following community standards

- 1) All participants are expected to participate in all activities and to be on time.
- 2) For overnight activities participants will be in bed with lights out when instructed and keep sleeping areas non-disruptive to others.
- 3) It is unacceptable for participants to leave the church or facility.
- 4) Everyone must be considerate of other's space, needs, health and property.
- 5) The use of ALL electronic devices (phones, laptops, handheld electronic games, etc.) are discouraged and at the discretion of the adults in charge and may be prohibited during all or parts of the youth activity.
- 6) Participants are to RESPECT the church, other's individual property, and the premises of any youth activity and will be financially responsible for willful destruction.
- 7) Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
- 8) Dress code: PG 13... Inappropriate: shorts or skirts too short; pants too low, unbuttoned, or unzipped; clothing that reveals too much; lack of undergarments... please use common sense and err on the side of modesty.
- 9) We shall treat each other with kindness and respect... gossiping, name-calling or harassment of any sort is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.

The following community standards are non-negotiable and if broken, parents will be contacted and the person(s) involved sent home:

- 1) Possession/use of alcohol or any illegal substance by any participant will not be allowed.
- 2) No firearms, fireworks of any kind, or weapons will be allowed.
- 3) Absolutely no inappropriate sexual behavior. Sleeping arrangements will have sexes separated; no shared sleep spaces including shared sleeping bags.
- 4) Non-participation, unwillingness to cooperate with adults or other youth will result in being asked to leave.

I have read and fully understand the above Standards. I fully agree to abide by and obey these Standards and that if I fail to do so, my parent/guardian will be notified, I will be sent home, and that I may be unable to return to the community for a determined period of time. I also understand that if circumstances require, the proper authorities will be notified.
